

## Glenmore Trails Walk

This leaflet is provided as a guide only. Please make sure that you have a map, suitable clothing and the equipment appropriate to your planned route, particularly in poor weather conditions. Remember – the conditions in the can change quickly in the mountains.

### Description

A short circular 2-mile walk through pine forests to the shore of Loch Morlich.

### Starting point

Start at the Hayfields car park on the Cairngorm ski road, just before the Glenmore snow gates at NH 980092, PH21 1QY.

### The walk

1. Take the track into the forest from the south end of the car park.
2. Go straight ahead on the track, until you reach a fork after about 0.4 miles. Keep right.
3. Continue along the track for another 0.5 miles until you reach a red marker post. Take the narrower path to your right.
4. Follow the path along the side of the loch until you reach another junction marked with a red post. Turn right here, towards the white marker post.
5. Follow the path around the wooded hill, heading to the right at the next white marker post.
6. When you reach the T-junction, turn left to re-join the larger track for the short distance back to the car park.
