

Loch an Eilein Walk

This leaflet is provided as a guide only. Please make sure that you have a map, suitable clothing and the equipment appropriate to your planned route, particularly in poor weather conditions. Remember – the conditions in the can change quickly in the mountains.

Description

A pleasant circular walk along a clear, gently undulating path around Loch an Eilein with its ruined castle. The route connects to a network of other paths so there are plenty of options to vary your route.

Starting point

By car: Park at the Loch an Eilein car park run by the Rothiemurchus Estate (charges apply). There are toilets and a small gift shop (in season), as well as some pleasant picnic tables.

The walk

1. From the car park head towards the Loch.
2. The walk is circular so either go straight ahead to begin your walk in an anticlockwise direction, or if you'd prefer to walk in a clockwise direction turn left and walk along the pebble beach to cross the outflow and then follow the path around the loch.
